TITLE		Consider approval of a yard debris and wood waste disposal fee increase at North Marion County Disposal Facility (NMCDF) & Salem-Keizer Recycling Transfer Station (SKRTS).							
Background		Republic Service's Pacific Region Compost (PRC) has increased their tipping rate \$12.49 per ton (from \$27.51 to \$40.00). Based on the increase from PRC, staff are requesting the board approve an increase to the yard debris and wood waste disposal fees at NMCDF and SKRTS, from \$47.00 per ton to \$59.49 per ton, effective December 1, 2016.							
		These fees are charged to non-franchised individuals delivering yard debris or wood waste to these two locations.							
Financial Impacts:		This is a fee increase of \$12.49 per ton for yard debris and wood waste disposal.							
Impacts to Department & External Agencies		The increase will impact customers at NMCDF and SKRTS who are disposing of yard debris or wood waste.							
Options for Consideration:		 Approve the yard debris and wood waste disposal fee increase from \$47.00 per ton to \$59.59 per ton at North Marion Disposal Facility and Salem-Keizer Recycling Transfer Station, effective December 1, 2016. Do not consider a fee increase at this time. 							
Recommendation:		Public Works staff recommends the Board approve the yard debris and wood waste disposal fee increase from \$47.00 per ton to \$59.59 per ton at North Marion Disposal Facility and Salem-Keizer Recycling Transfer Station, effective December 1, 2016.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the changes to the yard debris and wood waste disposal fees shall become effective December 1, 2016, and shall be in effect until replaced.
