lssue, Description & Background	Marion County and the City of Salem entered into cable television franchise agreements with Far-West Communications, Inc., dba Viacom Cable in 1994, renewing franchises granted by the jurisdictions in

(IGA) in 1988 to research cable television franchise issues on behalf of the City of Salem and Marion County. The commission acts in an advisory capacity to the jurisdictions regarding the renewal of any cable franchise agreement with any cable franchisee of the jurisdictions.

On December 17, 2004, the CRC reviewed Comcast's performance and held a public hearing to consider recommending renewal of the franchise, which was set to expire on January 27, 2005. The third five-year term of the franchise was recommended for approval by the CRC and board of commissioners approved the renewal with an expiration date of January 24, 2010. For several years after this Comcast staff was exclusively engaged in negotiating new franchises in the Portland-metro area, and the City of Salem and Marion County franchise negotiations were put on hold until they were resolved. During this time at the CRC's recommendation the board approved seven franchise extensions to June 17, 2010; December 8, 2010; May 11, 2011; January 11, 2013; January 14, 2014; December 31, 2014; December 31, 2015; December 31, 2016; March 31, 2017; June 30, 2017; October 31, 2017; and, April 30, 2018.

County and city staff have held a number of productive meetings with Comcast representatives in the past few months and are very close to completing negotiations for a new cable franchise. Due to the progress made at these meetings, the CRC is recommending the franchise be extended until June 30, 2018, which will allow staff time to administratively process the agreement and submit for approval before the Marion County Board of Commissioners and Salem City Council.

**Financial Impacts:** 

Marion County receives franchise fees in an amount equal to 5% of the cable services billed within the franchise area minus 40% that goes to the CRC. The net amount to the county in FY 2015-16 was \$229,139.58. Comcast will continue to pay the current franchise fees during the extension.
