This matter came before the Mid Willamette Valley Cable Regulatory Commission at its regularly scheduled public meeting on October 11, 2017, to consider approving an extension of the cable television franchise with Comcast of Oregon I, LLC.						
WHEREAS, Comcast of Oregon I, LLC ("Comcast") currently holds a cable franchise with the City of Salem and Marion County, which is due to expire on October 30, 2017; and,						
WHEREAS, the amount of time required to conclude negotiations and allow for public review of a new franchise agreement will extend beyond the current expiration date; and,						
WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to extend the current franchise for an additional period of time so that cable service to the public will not be interrupted.						
NOW, THEREFORE, the Mid Willamette Valley Cable Regulatory Commission recommends that the City of Salem and Marion County extend the franchise granted to Comcast of Oregon I, LLC until April 30, 2018, with the terms of the franchise agreements remaining in full force and effect during that period.
