TITLE Solid Waste Management Advisory Council (SWMAC) Membership Status

Issue, Description & Background
The Marion County Board of Commissioners formed the Solid Waste Management Advisory Council (SWMAC) on February 1, 1989. The SWMAC is a public body that was formed by the Marion County Board of Commissioners to make recommendations to the board. The council membership consists of eight citizen-at-large positions and eight from business and industry.

Chris Ream has been a member of SWMAC since June 2017 and has served in the role of Community Organization as a representative of the Habitat for Humanity ReStore. Chris no longer works for Habitat for Humanity but he would like to serve the rest of his four year term. We would like to reclassify Chris' position on the council from Community Organization to a Citizen-at-Large position. We currently have four vacancies for this role. Chris is currently the vice-chair of the council.

Impacts to Department & External Agencies None.

Options for Consideration:
1) Reappoint Chris Ream as a Citizen-at-Large on the SWMAC.
2) Do not appoint Chris Ream as a Citizen-at-Large on SWMAC. This would likely lead to his resignation.

Recommendation: Chris Ream has been an active and valued member of the council so our recommendation is to reappoint him to the council as a Citizen-at-Large.
