Issue, Description & Background The Marion County Budget Committee consists of three citizen members and the three county commissioners, who together set the recommended budgets for all county departments, operations and capital improvements.

There is currently a vacancy on the Budget Committee due to the resignation of Ferren Taylor. Denyc Boles is a qualified applicant recommended to be appointed as a replacement for the term expiring June 30, 2019.
