TITLE		FY17/18 Community Project Grant Applications and Funding Recommendations									
Issue, Description & Background		Marion County has budgeted over \$1.6 million in Oregon Video Lottery revenue in FY17/18 to support economic development efforts in Marion County. Of the \$1.6 million, \$100,000 is allocated for Community Project Grants (CPG), which provides funding to nonprofits, legal entities, or municipalities for projects that promote economic development through increasing the livability and safety within communities and unincorporated areas of Marion County. Community Services accepts applications on an ongoing basis; the Economic Development Advisory Board (EDAB) evaluated applications on June 13, 2018 and recommended funding two projects totaling \$44,000.									
Financial Impacts:		Awarded projects will benefit from the investment of Oregon Video Lottery funds.									
Impacts to Department & External Agencies		No impact to departments; revenues recommended for award by order are included in the approved FY17/18 budget.

Oregon Lottery Community Project Grants

BACKGROUND:

Community Services oversees the County's Economic Development program which includes administration of its Oregon Lottery Grant programs. A review of four Community Project Grant (CPG) applications was conducted at the June 2018 Economic Development Advisory Board (EDAB) meeting.

REVIEW PROCESS:

Staff reviewed applications for completeness and provided a copy to each EDAB member for independent review and scoring. At the June 13, 2018 EDAB meeting, members participated in a group review and discussed application strengths, weaknesses, and scores. Members were allowed to rescore applications as they saw fit following the group discussion, no adjustments were made to original scores.

COMMUNITY PROJECT GRANT SUMMARIES & RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Community Project Grant program has \$100,000 budgeted for FY17/18 with \$44,000 remaining available for award. Grants previously awarded for this fiscal year included the cities of: Aumsville (\$10,000), Mt. Angel (\$16,000), Turner (\$15,000), and Woodburn (\$15,000).

Marion County Economic Development

EDAB recommends funding the following proposals at the amounts requested:

- **City of Gervais \$25,000** of a \$154,200 budget for updates to the city's Master Plans for water, wastewater, and storm drain systems.
- **Jefferson School District \$19,000** of a \$600,000 budget for a waterline installation that will significantly upsize the public utility to serve the school district and future commercial users only North 2nd Street.
