Kevin Cameron was appointed to the Board of Commissioners on June 2014 and elected in November 2014. He previously served in the Oregon House of Representatives representing the residents of House District 19. He was first appointed in February 2005 and was re-elected to the position for an additional four terms. From 2008-2010 he served as the Assistant House Republican Leader and as the House Republican Leader during the historic tied 30/30 session of 2010-2012. In the legislature, he most recently served on the House Transportation and Economic Development Committee, Judiciary Committee, and was Vice Chair of the Rural Communities Committee.

Commissioner Cameron has over 40 years of experience in the hospitality industry as an employee, manager, entrepreneur and business owner. He is the co-founder/CEO of Cafe Today Restaurants. Cafe Today first opened in 1995 and currently has five restaurants operating in the Portland area. He has been an active member of the Salem community and has served in volunteer positions with Morningstar Community Church, Battle Creek Little League, OSU Alumni Board, and Corban University among others.
