TITLE Award presentation for the winners of the 2019 Student Recycling Art Calendar Contest

Issue, Description & Background Each year Public Works - Environmental Services and the Mid-Valley Garbage & Recycling Association (MVGRA) organize an art contest for K-12 students throughout Marion County. Students are asked to submit drawings that focus on waste prevention and reuse, and the winning entries are used to create a calendar, which is printed and distributed throughout the county.

The winning students will each receive a \$50 gift card and the overall winner will receive a \$100 gift card. Additionally, the teacher whose student's art is featured on the the front cover will receive a \$500 gift card for classroom use.

Financial Impacts: The costs to the Public Works-Environmental Services division will be approximately \$6,700, which includes the costs of printing the calendar and half the cost for the prizes. The other half of the prize costs will be paid by the MVGRA.
