MWHI Task Force June 2016 Subcommittee Update

AFFORDABLE HOUSING SUBCOMMITTEE

- Met at Courthouse Square on Thursday July 14, 2016. All members were in attendance.
- Affordable Housing and Financial Subcommittees will begin meeting jointly as many of the topics presented are intertwined.
- Discussed topics
 - Potential projects with a layering of funding sources and inclusion of social service aspects for clients
 - Potentially seeking further grant funds through the jurisdictions
 - Barriers that will need to be addressed such as prevailing wages, system development charges, and property taxes.
- The subcommittee will be collecting and evaluating information regarding funding sources, regulatory requirements, and policy revisions in respect to grant writing at the jurisdiction level.

TRANSITIONAL HOUSING/SHELTERS SUBCOMMITTEE

- Initial meeting July 11, 2016.
- Discussion to:
 - o Identify existing transitional housing and shelter resources in the community.
 - Review reasonably anticipated additional resources coming online in the foreseeable future.
- Even as augmented, the resources are clearly inadequate for the demand.
- Framed the question of our target population(s).
- No decisions were made at this meeting.
- Follow-up meeting in the next three weeks.

PUBLIC SAFETY SUBCOMMITTEE

- First meeting June 22, 2016.
- Reviewed our charge.
- Reviewed current activates in the two county area for LEAD and runaway and homeless youth (RHY), and talked about where this committee would like to focus its efforts.
- Decided to focus on the RHY system in Marion and Polk counties.
 - Consensus was that this RHY population (youth young adult) would give us the best return on our investment and reduce the homeless population pipeline.
 - Cyndi Leinassar has reached out to HOME Youth & Resource Center, HOST, and Jackson Street Youth Shelter to co-present current activities and collaborations.
- The taskforce additionally wants to know:
 - 1. What are the measurable outcomes and vision for their collaboration?
 - 2. What are the gaps in the system?
 - 3. How do they see affordable housing supporting their work?

- 4. How can this taskforce support further advance their work?
- RHY collaborating agencies are working on their effort currently and would not be able to present until late August.

VETERANS SUBCOMMITTEE

- Meetings held June 9th and July 14.
- Many different agencies participating in supplying us with valuable information and direction.
 - Starting with finding funding and grants to fund raising.
 - Navigating through governmental agencies and local levels of city and county agencies to purchase property.
 - Looking to different groups to help with construction.
 - Having housing available and ready to rent
 - Putting the Veteran on the path to permanent housing.
- Plan to meet with people to help with fund raising and those who have successful programs in place.

FOCUS GROUP AND COALITION COORDINATION SUBCOMMITTEE

- Met on June 30th
- Finalized the questions that will be utilized to gain insight from people experiencing homelessness in order to bring feedback to the MWHI Task Force.
- Worked on the drafts of questions that we will ask community partners and the community at large.
 - o Draft questions taken to the Emergency Housing Network on July 14 to gain their perspective and input.
 - The EHN provided insight into our need to create an asset map for Coalition Coordination and understanding the depth of services provided throughout Marion and Polk counties.
- The next meeting is July 28th, at noon at Courthouse Square.
