Topics from the September 15, 2016 subcommittee meeting that were slated for further review:

- 1. SKSD 10 day policy;
- 2. Hygiene items for students;
- 3. Increase awareness around homeless students;
- 4. Laundry facilities needed;
- 5. Workforce development;
- 6. Need for resource center/drop-in center;
- 7. Support Dream Center expansion;
- 8. Professional development for teachers; and
- Bridging the educational gap between mainstream and alternative school mentor/tutoring programs.

Some of these topics can be combined into a few recommendations. Below are some draft recommendations to start the conversation on the 9th.

DRAFT Recommendation 1:

Initiate a conversation with the SKSD to; advocate for amendments to the ten day absenteeism policy to accommodate homeless students; promote more school-based work skills development programs; provide tutoring/mentorship for students in the gap between mainstream and alternative school; and provide professional development opportunities for educators and staff dealing with homeless and high risk populations.

DRAFT Recommendation 2:

Support CAA/HOME in expanding/developing the Youth and Resource Center. *Laundry facilities provided*.

DRAFT Recommendation 3:

Support expansion of the Dream Center in West Salem, and advocate for other communities to adopt the center's model to expand services throughout Salem.
