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

Trauma Informed Programming

Trauma

Results from an event, series of events, or set of circumstances that is experienced by an individual as physically or emotionally harmful or life-threatening and that has lasting effects on the individual's functioning and mental, social emotional or spiritual well being (SAMHSA, 2014).
