If adopted the District would use tax revenue to replace a 2004 ambulance, add emergency personnel for 24-hour coverage, and	
cover increased operating costs.	
The Board is asking the voters to approve a \$0.81 per thousand tax levy for the next five years beginning July 1, 2024, and	
expiring June 30, 2029.	
Homeowners with an assessed property valuation of \$200,000.00 would pay \$162.00 in property taxes.	
The measure would raise approximately \$677,017.00 in 2024-25, \$690,557.00 in 2025-26, \$704,368.00 in 2026-27, \$718,456.00	
in 2027-28 and \$732,825.00 in 2028-29, for a total of \$3,523,223.
