## Public Hearing Set on Proposed Revisions to County's Dog Control Ordinance

The Marion County Board of Commissioners will be holding a hearing to receive public comment on proposed revisions to the county's dog control ordinance. This public hearing is scheduled for this Wednesday, October 22 at 9:30 a.m. in the Senator Hearing Room of Courthouse Square, 555 Court Street NE, Salem.

The purpose of the dog control ordinance is to establish licensing and other dog-related regulations, processes for handling of stray dogs by the Marion County Dog Shelter, and processes for enforcement, hearings, and appeals.
