One position would be external facing and work with community coalitions and community partners and the other would be a Peer Support worker, to support individuals navigate obtaining housing and barriers. The Health Advisory Board entertained a motion to support the 3 decision packages and the motion was approved. HAB will write a Letter of Support.</p> <p>The 3rd FTE would be a Behavioral Health Emergency Preparedness position.</p>
12:00-12:15	Census 2020 (Katrina)	<p>Planning has begun around Oregon for the 2020 Census. There will be a meeting on April 24th to involve individuals and agencies to take an active role in collecting data for the 2020 Census. There will be a decision made in April regarding the citizenship question on the form. HHS will partner with all of the cities in Marion County. Oregon receives \$10 million that relies on Census data.</p>
