Some frequent factors: chronic pain, many individuals have been seen by their primary care doctor within 30 days of their suicide attempt, major life events, eviction from home, having to relinquish a pet to a shelter. There have been 26 deaths by suicide in MC in 2019.
		MCHHS has a Zero Suicide initiative- no one in services dies by suicide is the goal. Staff are surveyed and trained on this program. There will be a Zero Suicide Day in September-date to be announced.
		Local Resources and Trainings-ASSIST is a 2 day, high level training, applications will be accepted through June; Mid- Valley Suicide Prevention Coalition has a new website with many helpful resources <u>https://mvsuicideprevention.org/</u> ; QPR (Question, Persuade, Refer) trainings are available in the community; 4 day CONNECT training at MCHHS focuses on building postvention plans.
