11:45-12:00	Communications & Branding (Jenna)	The Facebook live discussion for mental health awareness month received a high number of positive responses and likes. People who have watched the video responded it has started many conversations in the work place and at home.

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12:00-12:20	Health & Human Services (HHS) Suicide Prevention- Internally and Externally (Cydney)	<p>A short power point was presented on the suicide statistics in Marion County. Some frequent factors: chronic pain, many individuals have been seen by their primary care doctor within 30 days of their suicide attempt, major life events, eviction from home, having to relinquish a pet to a shelter. There have been 26 deaths by suicide in MC in 2019.</p> <p>MCHHS has a Zero Suicide initiative- no one in services dies by suicide is the goal. Staff are surveyed and trained on this program. There will be a Zero Suicide Day in September-date to be announced.</p> <p>Local Resources and Trainings-ASSIST is a 2 day, high level training, applications will be accepted through June; Mid-Valley Suicide Prevention Coalition has a new website with many helpful resources https://mvsuicideprevention.org/; QPR (Question, Persuade, Refer) trainings are available in the community; 4 day CONNECT training at MCHHS focuses on building postvention plans.</p>
