Committee – Reports Clinical Sups WVCH Intake Coordinators Data Managers		12:30-1:00p	All	 Clinical Sups – ADHD –WVCH/BCN will be implementing new policy and protocol. Discussion around children and adult pre-authorization expectations and ADHD plan of care for children less than 6 years of age. Outcome Rating Scale (handout) discussed as a tool to measure members well-being and satisfaction with care. Further discussion needed around frequency of using this tool with members; ease of administering and cost. Rental Assistance – Target population for assistance is members with serious mental illnesses that have had illness for over one year. Grant money for has not yet been received. One parameter is that Marion County cannot have more than 20% of its members in one complex. Intake Coordinators – Outreach services through CAPS – found that many members were indecisive about Mental Health even after we offered assistance. After our efforts, our overall access reached almost 92% total access for March.
