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## **I. Announcements and Introductions**

- Clear Paths announced that they will be having a CPC inspection in April
- Bridgeway hired an additional adolescent treatment clinician. They have 90 kids in their program
- Polk has had 22 referrals to the jail program that was started with the 2<sup>nd</sup> chance grant.

SBIRT training provided by BCN on March 14<sup>th</sup>

- It will be held in the Roth's conference center in West Salem

Enhanced detox update

- Still waiting for the money to come in so they can start the final process.

LADPC

- The committee is working on developing a training around seniors addressing addictions including gambling.
  - SAMHSA definition of a senior is anyone over 50 years old.
  - BRS is working on building a curriculum for seniors

## **II. HOAP – Paul**

Co-Location of Substance Abuse treatment provider at HOAP

- The staff at HOAP work with around 125 clients that are homeless and bipolar – schizophrenic

- NWHS is looking for a provider to come in and provide some screening, classes, brief intervention, and group services for addictions.

### **III. Coordinated Care Organization – Jim/Dean/Cary/Everyone**

- February Session passed SB1580 to Authorize Oregon Health Authority to launch a CCO
- OHA issued for Comment
  - Draft Request Application
  - Draft Contract
  - Draft Administrative Rule
- Process has 4 start up periods – First start up period
  - Applications are due April 30
  - Financial proposal by May 14<sup>th</sup>
  - Starting CCO August 1<sup>st</sup>
    - 3 more cycles this year
- Two groups are working on how the CCO's will work
  - Clinical Design – integration
    - Clinical Advisory Council
    - Consumer Advisory Council – 50% public
    - System wide inventory of services
  - Governance Board

### **IV. Data/Discussion – Dean/Scott/Dwight**

#### **Review MPCHP CD Report - Dean**

- We are concerned about how to make it to the end of the contract year without going over budget.
- We don't want to divert or close doors because it is a challenge to get them open again in a timely manner.
- The ADES need to know that the funding is low, so that they don't over refer people to the agencies.

#### **Summary of Discharge Outcome Data Report from Feb Supervisors Mtg - Scott**

- Looking at successful completion. This could become an outcome measure. Looking at ways to increase retention and engagement.
  - OHP completions are higher than the indigent

#### **Reaching SE66 Targets as defined by AMH**

- Tomoko has made a guideline for Clear Paths that has clear criteria
- The state is taking under advisement that everyone should be able to count at discharge not just the ones that started and ended in this fiscal year.
- The target is 641 by June 30<sup>th</sup> and right now we are at 230.

## **V. Addictions and Mental Health Division/County Addiction Tx Interests - Everyone**

AMH discussion regarding direct contracting for alcohol and drug residential treatment services.

- Suggesting there is no changes in the Payment structure in the first year. There is still some concern about the oversight.
