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## **I. Announcements and Introductions**

- Bridgeway has started their adolescent co-occurring treatment program
- VMH has 4 new clinicians coming on in the next couple weeks
- **Options – Post Partum Depression**
  - Options submitted a proposal to assume PPD, which has been provisionally accepted.
- **Interest for other Prevention Projects**
  - 2 applications to date
  - Deadline for requests is mid July
- **Cover Oregon – Campaign Beginning**
  - Portal opens October 1 for January 1<sup>st</sup> coverage date
  - CO 1st goal is to get 40,000 people through their portal
  - Health Kids contract ended 06/30/13. Will now be going through CO
  - Everyone is guaranteed to have insurance
  - OHP standard will most likely be going through Cover Oregon (CO)

- What does integration mean to us?
- Need to suggest a collaborative approach to what is integration and how do we achieve this goal.

- Explain what mental health does and how to access services, including prescribing services
- Bring forward ideas regarding how MH assists PCP care
- Access to consultation for medication requests
  - Take prescribing protocol
  - Guidelines on prescriptions
- Look for opportunity to discuss cost savings with mental health and physical health
  - Risk sharing for common goals
  - Keeping members out of the hospital

### **III. Psychiatric / Medication Management Services**

- Continued Evaluation of Data
- Discussed complexity of data and intended use of it regarding opportunity to collaborated with PCP/WVCH for future contracting models
- Discussed development of a Shared Savings Funding Model
  - Incentivize Primary care to take members back or to provide funds for the members that primary care is unable to take back

### **IV. Impacting Access – Individuals 1<sup>st</sup> Approach**

- Intake Group – Flat Rate – Discussed aspects to consider
  - Creation of the group/development - including start up cost
  - Early indication that majority of providers interested in offering a group
    - New Perspectives
    - BRS
    - CCS
    - NWHS
    - VMH
- Capacity Rate for Open Access Slots
  - Interest in primary care/behaviorist easy/immediate access to services
  - Interest in creating capacity across the panel both in the am/pm and for children & adults.
  - Model - reimburse for capacity for a pilot time whether the individual attends scheduled initiative
- Access Data Reporting Changes
  - Data changes will be reported to the BCN
  - The intake coordinator will review all calls documented as Appointment Offered No Response starting January 2013 to determine if there was an actual appointment that would have been offered. These calls will be updated to reflect Appointment offered-Decline.
  - Changes need to be complete by August 15<sup>th</sup>
- Responding to Missed Appointments
  - Options' is in process of hiring a person (Engagement Specialist) to do outreach to members at initial call and throughout services.

## **V. Contract Updates**

- As a result of the Easter Seals closure, mid year contractual adjustment have been made to some agency contracts based on the number of members that were transferred to their agencies from Easter Seals.
- Incentives have been adjusted accordingly based on the program closure and the contractual adjustments
