Tin Cans & Aluminum Metal Beer & Wine Caps
 Tin Cans & Aluminum - rinse first. Remove labels and add to mixed recycling roll can. No need to flatten. Metal Beer & Wine caps ok.

Newspapers
 Newspapers
 Yellow ink ok.

Mixed Scrap Paper
 This includes: Junk mail, paper, computer paper, cardstock, forms, gift wrap, post-it notes, paper bags, greeting cards, file folders, envelopes, paper plates, laminated paper on marked paper bag, mail boxes, label paper, white & colored ledger paper, magazines, phone books.

Cardboard, Greyboard, Paperboard & Paperback Books
 Remove & discard plastic liners. Flatten box.

Plastic Containers
 Clean first. Labelled #1-7. Please discard caps & liners.

NEWS Aerosol Cans!
 Remove spray tip & discard. All cans must be empty.

NO
 medical waste, glass, plastic bags, greasy or waxed cardboard, Styrofoam, syringes, plastic bottle caps, or garbage in the Blue Star Cart. Lid must be completely shut for automated system to work properly.
