PURPOSE AND SIGNIFICANCE:

The purpose of the CAPS website (<http://www.co.marion.or.us/HLT/CAPS>) is to provide up-to-date information to IDS Providers and Oregon Health Plan (OHP) Members. The website contains detailed information about the IDS and its Providers, the Mid-Valley Behavioral Care Network (MVBCN), CAPS and the programs it oversees, links to Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs), and Community Resources. The website is designed to provide assistance to its Members, IDS Providers, and other community networks.

PROCESS AND/OR PROCEDURE:

The following information is provided on the CAPS website in the following sections:

About CAPS: This section provides detailed information about CAPS and its staff. In addition, it includes overviews of the following programs and their contact information: Consumer Care Partnerships (CCP), Local Alcohol and Drug Planning Committee (LADPC), and Systems Management Group (SMG).

Community Network: This section provides information about the organizations that CAPS oversees and/or coordinates with. These organizations include: Chemical Dependency Services, Co-Management, CCP, Co-Occurring Substance Use and Mental Health Disorders, Evidence-Based Practices, and New Solutions.

IDS: This section provides detailed information about the IDS system and its services, including the system mission and its goals. There is also information about the IDS Committees and links to their meeting minutes. Lastly, this section contains an overview of the Mid-Valley Independent Physician’s Association (MVIPA) and Performance Health Technology (PH Tech), and how they are integrated within the IDS.

IDS Agencies: This section of the website contains each IDS Provider’s location, mailing addresses, phone numbers, and links to their external web page.

IDS Handbook: This section of the website provides, in downloadable PDF, the IDS Handbook.

Meeting Minutes: This section provides all meeting agendas and minutes for the IDS Advisory Committee, LADPC, and SMG in downloadable PDF.

MVBCN: This section of the website provides an overview of the MVBCN and its connection to CAPS and the IDS. There are also links to the MVBCN's Member Handbook and the MVBCN Provider Manual. In addition, there is information about and links to the MVBCN's Quality Improvement Plan.

OARs: This section includes links to the State of Oregon Administrative Rules site that allows the public to search and view all OARs.

Resources: This section of the website contains information and links to various resources within the community and region. Although CAPS is not responsible for the listed organizations, we do provide brief descriptions of their services. Inquires regarding resource scope and detailed information should be directed to that organization. Each organization's contact information is included.
