Display space:

- ✓ Each city can claim a space 10 feet x 10 feet in Columbia Hall at the State Fairgrounds.
- ✓ Draping between displays, an 8 foot table and two chairs are provided.
- ✓ Your display can be staffed or static.
- ✓ City displays must be set up on Wednesday, July 9, between 12 noon and 8 pm.
- ✓ Displays must be removed no later than 8 am on Monday, July 14. Columbia Hall will be open until 7 pm on Sunday, July 13 to take down displays.
- ✓ **FREE** tickets into the fair will be provided for those staffing city displays and no charge for parking.

Good-natured competition:

Winners will be announced Thursday evening, July 11, at the welcome reception and barbecue for state legislators and mayors hosted by the Marion County Commissioners.

Criteria for the winning ribbons:

- Originality ● Use of Fair theme ● Attractive / Colorful display ● Number of community partners participating with the booth ● All cities will get a ribbon recognizing your participation
