**Marion County Offices Relocate to MaPS Building**

SALEM – This week relocation of county offices continues as the Children and Families Department, Finance, Treasury, Marion County Business Enterprise Enhancement (MCBEE) team, and Board of Commissioners' Office move to leased office space located at 451 Division Street NE, Salem. These county offices will share the second floor the MaPS Building.

The Children and Families Department is slated to move first and will be closed for business through Wednesday, September 8. The office will reopen on Thursday, September 9, at the Division Street office.

The Finance Department and Treasury will be next to relocate to the MaPS Building. Both offices will be closed during the move through Thursday, September 9. Regularly scheduled check runs have been canceled for the week of September 6.

On Friday, September 10, the Board of Commissioners' Office will relocate to the MaPS Building. Limited counter service will be available at Courthouse Square through mid-day Friday, with services available at the new offices in the MaPS Building beginning Monday, September 13.

Remaining offices scheduled to relocate include the District Attorney's Office, Business Services, Information Technology and the Law Library. All county offices will be moved by September 28. The Board of Commissioners will hold regularly scheduled board sessions in the Senator Hearing Room of Courthouse Square through Wednesday, September 29.
