Board of Commissioners to Visit Area Communities for Board Sessions

SALEM – The Marion County Board of Commissioners will be visiting area communities for weekly board sessions during October, November and December. As county offices complete relocations from the Courthouse Square building, a final Board of Commissioners regular meeting will be held in the Senator Hearing Room on September 29.

Due to limited availability of meeting room space on Wednesday mornings, the board will meet throughout the county during the last quarter of 2010 as a more permanent location is sought. “This schedule provides the board the opportunity to visit local cities and meet with people in the neighboring communities as part of their weekly meeting,” said Chief Administrative Officer John Lattimer. He went on to say, “The board is encouraging community participation and area residents are invited to attend board sessions as they are held in each city.”

As part of the meeting schedule the board will visit Silverton, Stayton, Woodburn, Keizer, Aumsville, and Mt. Angel. Salem area meetings will be held in the Salem-Keizer School District board room. Beginning today, Courthouse Square will now be closed to the public as the Law Library moves to new quarters in the Ticor Building at 234 High Street, Salem. All other county offices have already completed their moves from Courthouse Square.
