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County Sets Public Hearing on Alternative Procurement Process

Salem, OR - The Marion County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing regarding use of an alternative procurement process for Design-Build project services for the Courthouse Square Complex. The hearing will be held on Wednesday, October 26, 2011, at 9:30 a.m. in the Commissioners' Board Room located at 1115 Commercial Street NE, Salem.

In addition, the Salem Area Mass Transit District will also hold a public hearing at their regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday, October 27, 2011, at 6:30 p.m. at the Salem City Council Chambers, located at 555 Liberty Street SE, Salem.

The county and transit district are considering utilizing a Design-Build contracting method in order to obtain a market based cost for repair of the complex. The Design-Build process is where one contractor is responsible for architectural/engineering services, as well as construction under a single contract. A market cost is necessary as the county and transit district consider the future of the site.
