

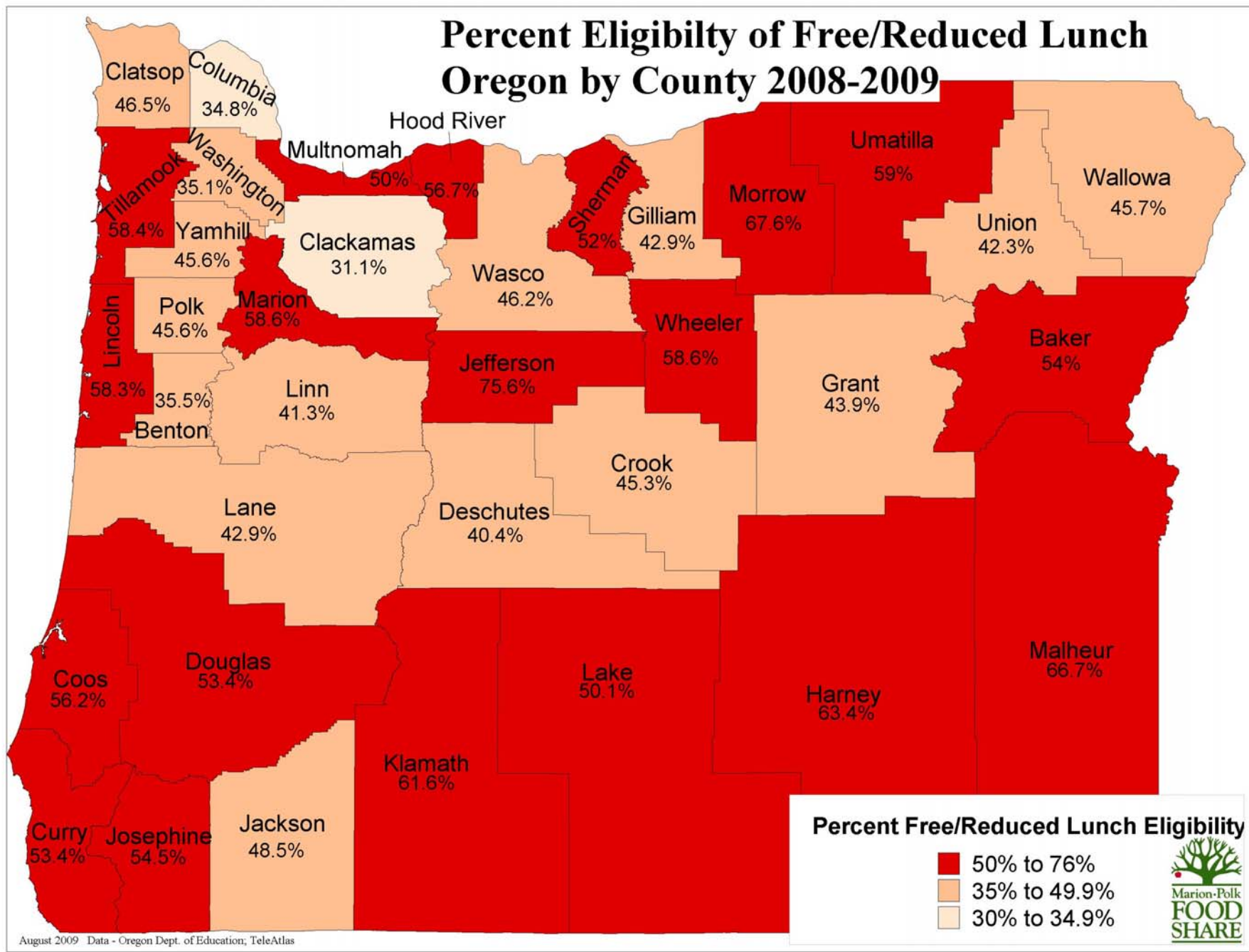

Percent Free/Reduced Lunch Eligibility

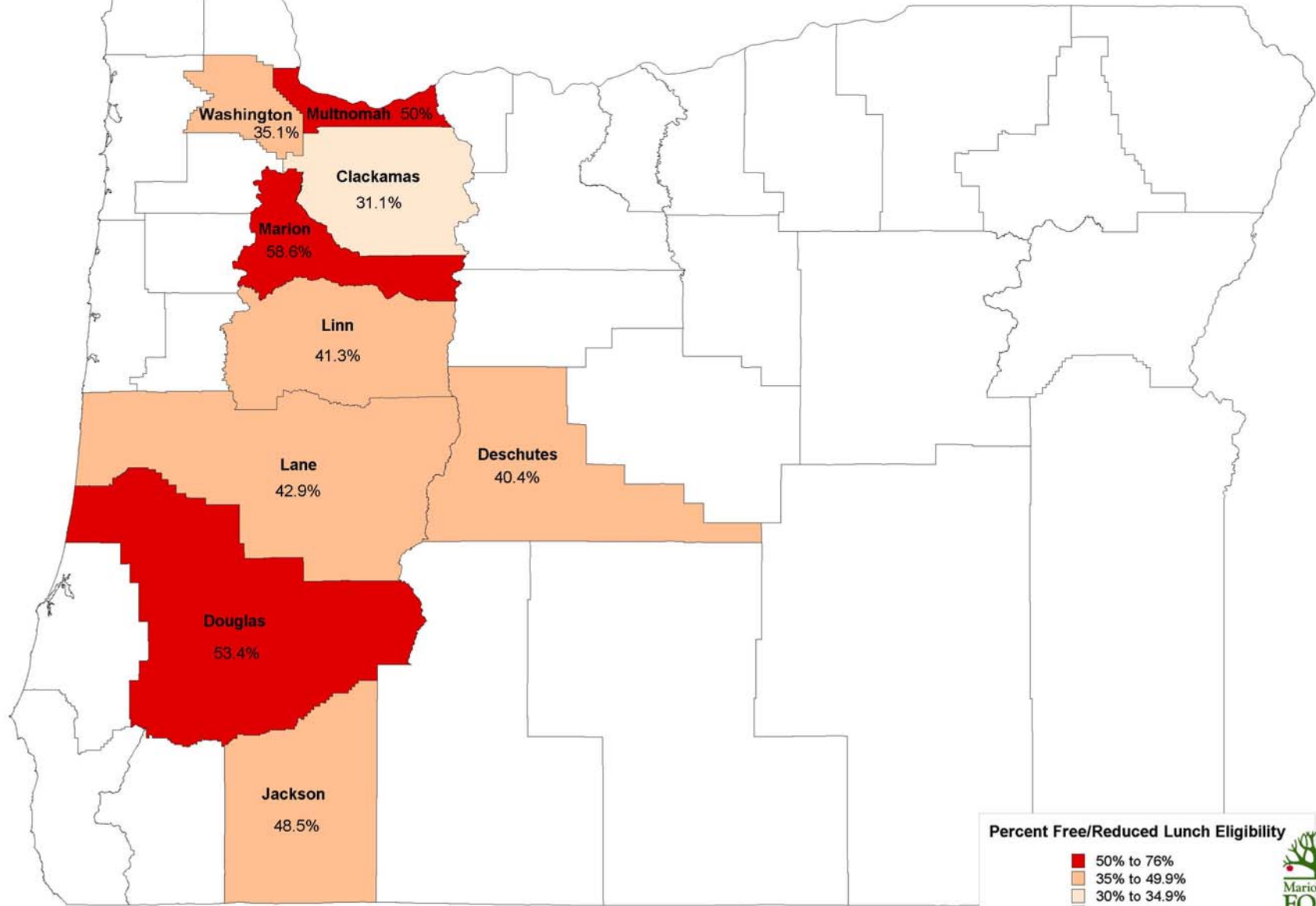

Counties with Greater Than 100,000 Population

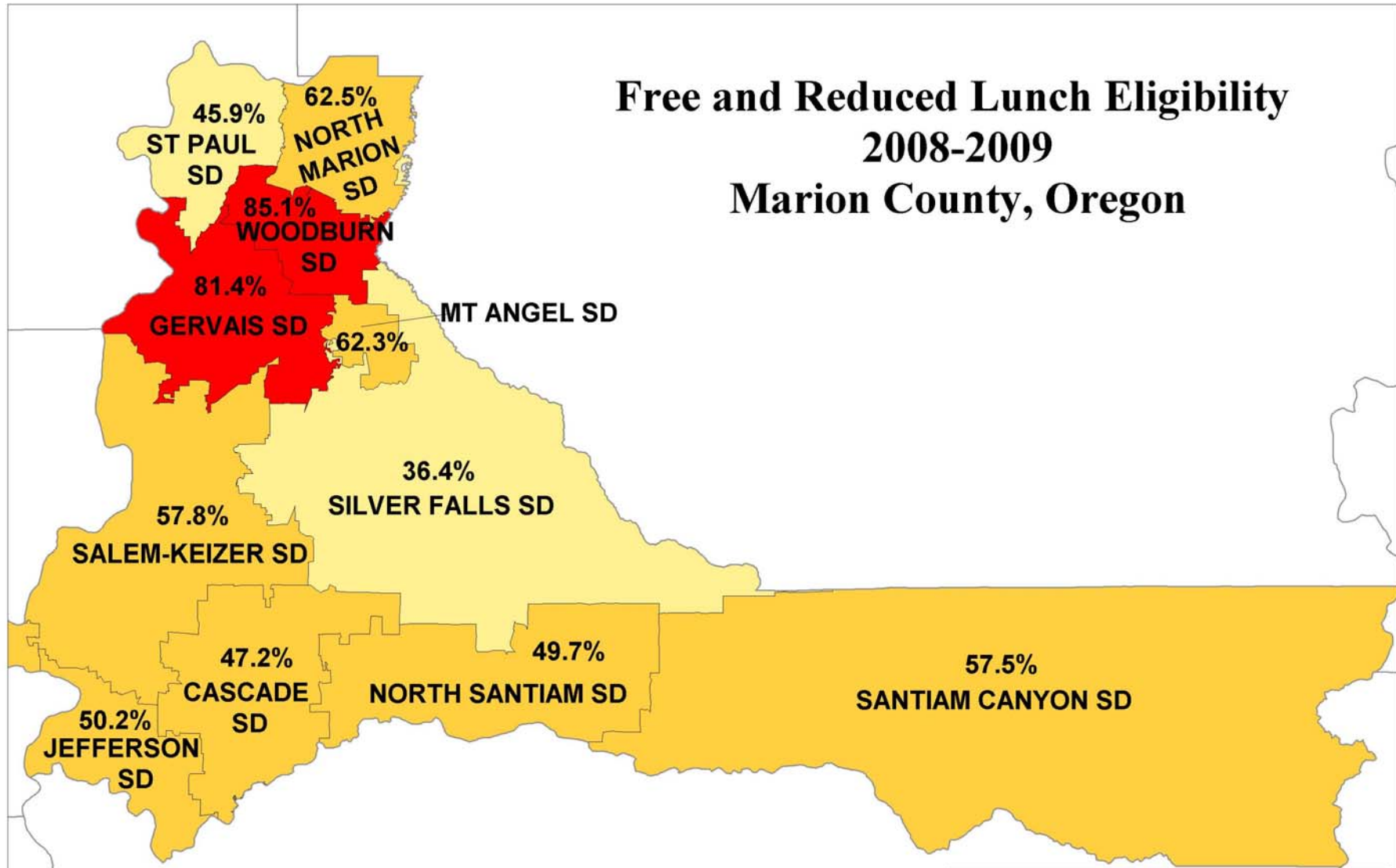

Free and Reduced Lunch Eligibility 2008-2009 Marion County, Oregon



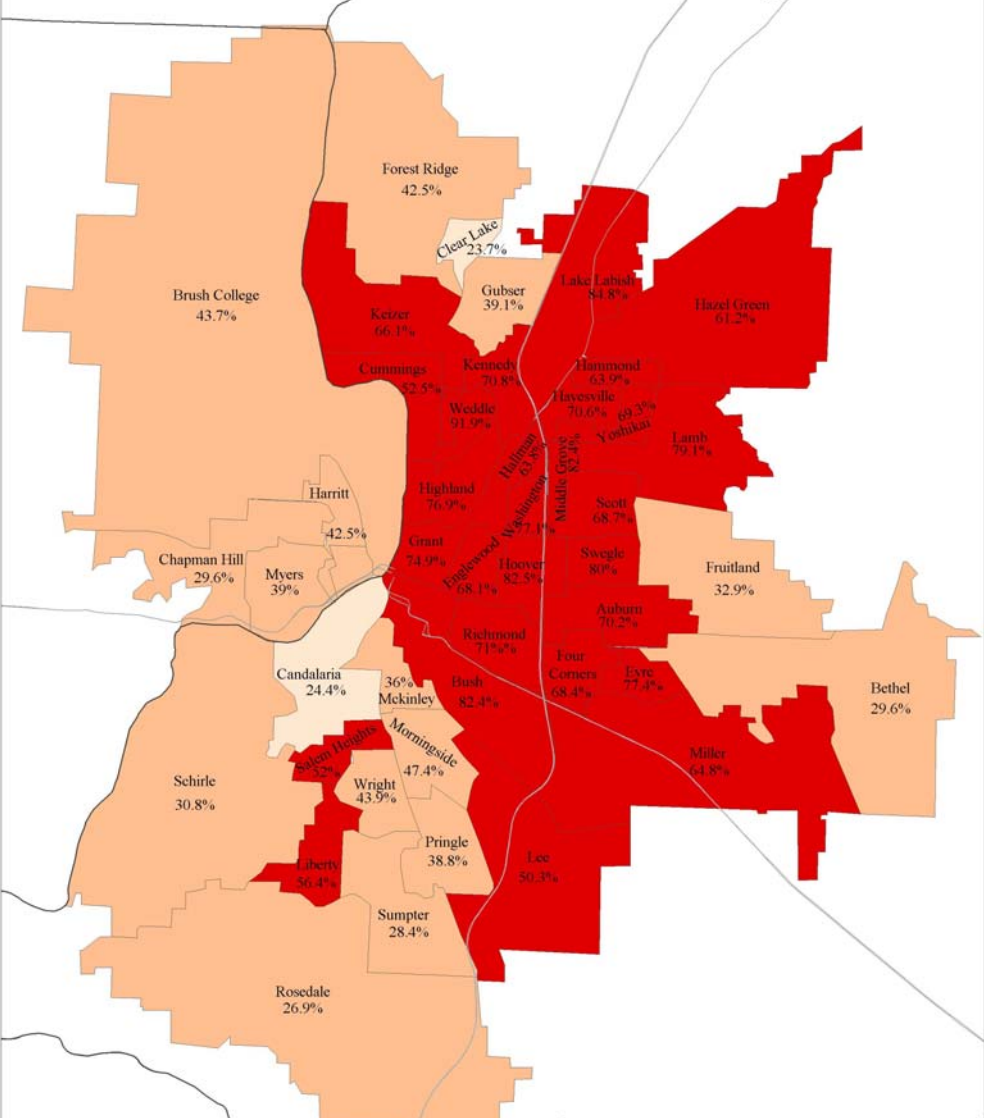
