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County to Host Local Officials Roundtable & Town Hall with Veterans' Services Task Force

SALEM – Marion County will be hosting a roundtable discussion between local officials and the Governor's Veterans' Services Task Force on Tuesday, August 12th at 2-3:30 PM in the Senator Hearing Room on the first floor of the Courthouse Square office building at 555 Court St, NE in Salem.

During this informal meeting, Task Force members want to hear from local city and county leaders about any concerns or questions they may have about veterans' services or programs. All mayors, city councilors and city managers are invited and encouraged to attend.

This roundtable will be followed by a 7-9 PM town hall meeting to listen to citizen concerns about veterans services and to discuss the progress of the Task Force.

With the signing of Executive Order 08-08, Governor Ted Kulongoski formed the Task Force to compile, review and evaluate current veterans policies, procedures and programs. They are charged with developing recommendations for improvements to ensure that Oregon veterans have access to the services they need. The Governor's Task Force has been on a statewide tour that has included roundtables and town halls in more than 22 cities across Oregon.

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
