Public Workshop on the Marion County Solid Waste Management Plan

Marion County would like its citizens to help determine the future of garbage disposal in Marion County. The county is having a solid waste management plan prepared that will consider options for waste reduction, reuse, recycling, composting, and disposal of waste for the next 5 to 10 years.

The county is holding a public workshop to inform the public on the various methods and options for waste disposal available, and to solicit feedback on those options. The workshop is being held on Monday, September 22, 2008, at 6:30 p.m. in the South Salem High School library (1910 Church St. SE, Salem).

The development of the solid waste plan is ongoing, with public comment opportunities occurring almost every month during the meetings of the Marion County Solid Waste Management Advisory Council, which holds its meetings on the 4th Tuesday of every month at 6:30 p.m. in the Senator Hearing Room of Courthouse Square (555 Court St. NE, Salem).
