- Seed spitting contestants will be divided into 4 flights for scoring: Men's, Women's, Youth (8-15 years), and Children (7 years and under).
- Athletes may run towards the spit-off line, hold a firm position, stand or sit. No extraordinary elevations will be allowed. All competition seeds must fall within the designated playing field.
