County Hotline Available For Flood Damage Reporting

Salem, OR – Marion County Emergency Management is asking residents in the unincorporated areas of Marion County to report flood damage at (503) 588-5108 or by e-mail at krowland@co.marion.or.us. County officials must submit an Initial Damage Assessment report by Friday, January 27, to Oregon Emergency Management.

The Initial Damage Assessment with estimated damage costs is necessary to determine whether last week's winter storm event will qualify for a federal disaster declaration and potential assistance from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

To report damage residents are encouraged to either contact their insurance company, city emergency management office, or the county depending on individual circumstances. Callers will need to provide the following information when reporting damage:
