This matter came before the Marion County Board of Commissioners, acting as the Marion Local Contract Review Board (Board), on at its regularly scheduled public meeting on Wednesday, October 26, 2011.

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the Marion County Board of Commissioner’s Office seeks an exemption from Marion County Public Contracting Rules, pursuant to Sections 40-0600 to 40-0690, which provide for the use of alternative contracting methods for public improvements as may be directed by the Board under ORS 279C.335; and

WHEREAS, Section 40-0620 allows the Board to direct the use of alternative contracting methods as an exception to the prescribed public contracting practices in Oregon and its use must be justified in accordance with public contracting code and Marion County Public Contracting Rules; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners’ Office wants to use a Request for Proposal (RFP) as allowed under Marion County Public Contracting Rules Section 40-0650 as an alternative contracting method to solicit for design-build services for the remediation of the Courthouse Square complex, the Board must authorize the use of competitive proposals for a public improvement under the competitive bidding requirements of ORS 279C.335; and

WHEREAS, the Board has received justification and testimony during the properly noticed and scheduled public hearing on October 26, 2011 and finds the use of a Request for Proposal, as outlined in Exhibit A, to solicit for design-build services for remediation of the Courthouse Square complex is justified and consistent with the Marion County Public Contracting Rules; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Board adopts the findings attached hereto as Exhibit A and grants an exemption to allow the use of a Request for Proposal (RFP) as an alternative contracting method and issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) for design-build services for remediation of the Courthouse Square complex project.
