Marion Water Quality Advisory Committee Seeking Members

Do you have an interest in the potential impact of construction on water quality? Do you want to learn more about the current issues and concerns associated with development? Marion County Public Works Environmental Services has an opportunity for two community members to serve on a limited duration committee and participate in discussions to recommend policy improvement. This committee is called the Marion Water Quality Advisory Committee.

Committee volunteers have the opportunity to attend one meeting a month for 12-18 months. Meetings are scheduled for two hours during a Tuesday. County staff members will provide background information to the committee to facilitate an informed discussion. In addition to community volunteers, the committee membership will consist of representatives from construction, soil and water conservation, a watershed council, engineering, environmental services and land-use planning.
