The Fresh Start Market and Espresso is hosting Summerfest 2009 on August 24-27. Summerfest includes four days of great lunches, fresh fruits and vegetables for sale and a daily raffle for handcrafted items designed by program youth.

The purpose of Fresh Start Market and Espresso is to provide an opportunity for youth to pay back restitution to victims of crime while learning job skills. The youth learn skills related to customer service, handling cash, barista, merchandizing, stocking and various other tasks oriented towards the daily operational duties of the Fresh Start Market and Espresso.

The menu for lunch will be: Monday: fish tacos; Tuesday: BBQ chicken; Wednesday: chicken or steak kabobs; and Thursday: BBQ burgers or hot dogs. All dishes come with side dishes and the cost is \$6. Lunch is served each day from 11:00 a.m.-1:30 p.m. Hawaiian shaved ice will also be available for purchase.

A large variety of fresh picked fruits and vegetables from the garden will be available for purchase.
