

# WANTED

**Name:** Garlic mustard (*Alliaria petiolata*)

**Aliases:** None known

**Description:** Biennial up to 3 feet; scalloped kidney-shaped leaves; single flower stalks with multiple 4-petaled flowers at the top; garlic odor when leaves are crushed

**Last seen:** So far in northern counties along trails, in recreation areas, and in forest understories

**Charge:** Displacing native and desirable vegetation; reducing diversity; reducing wildlife forage
