Rock N' Roll Legends Coming To the 2009 Marion County Fair

The 2009 Marion County Fair is just one month away. Slated for July 9-12 at the Oregon State Fairgrounds, the theme of this year's county fair is "Green and Growing, Celebrating 150 Years of A Clean and Green Oregon."

Highlighting the main stage will be a performance Saturday, July 11 by the Legends of Rock N' Roll Show. Featured will be Justin Shandor. Justin has been proclaimed as *"The World's Closest Elvis Look & Sound Alike."* Justin has been featured on CBS as well as the front page of USA Today. He will perform Elvis from the 50's to the 70's. In addition, Ted Vigil will be performing. In 2006, Ted won the national title for "Talent Quest" in Laughlin, Nevada, for his astonishing resemblance to the late, great, John Denver. After his win, he has performed a John Denver Tribute show throughout the country with rave reviews.

Other 2009 fair highlights will include: the culmination of the Marion County 150 relay salute to Oregon's birthday: runners will enter the fairgrounds Saturday evening, concluding the five week event through 150 miles of Marion County. In addition, there will be green displays, Ag day, an international flyball competition, teen dance off; numerous demonstrations from karate to hip hop dance to skateboarding, the annual KBZY pretty baby contest, and much more. Of course, there will be plenty of animals and livestock competitions, rides and the tradition fair foods.

Admission is adults: \$7.50, youth 6-11: \$3.50 and children five and under five are free. A family pass is \$24 and includes up to two adults and four youth. Parking is free.
