Clean Water Starts Here...

Clean water starts with your how you care for your lawn! Here are some tips for environmentally friendly lawn care: - Choose compost or organic, slow release fertilizer for your lawn and garden. - Keep your grass at least 3 inches. This encourages healthy regrowth and protects the roots. - Leave grass clippings on your lawn. As they break down, it releases nitrogen back into the soil and reduces the need for fertilizer. - If you want to remove weeds from your lawn, either hand-pull while the soil is wet or choose an all natural weed killer (see picture below). - Pick up after your pet to reduce the spread
