Name: False brome (*Brachypodium sylvaticum*)

Aliases: Slender false brome

Description: Fat, hairy and lazy. That is, the blades (leaves) are quite wide; the edges of the blades and the lower portions of the stems are noticeably hairy, and the overall habit of the plant is rather lax and droopy

Last seen: Lurking in the Santiam canyon area in wide swaths along the River, through portions of Gates, following the riverbank in a westerly direction

Charge: Increasing fire danger; depleting forage and habitat for wildlife; inhibiting restoration efforts; inhibiting seedling tree establishment; reducing forage quality for livestock
