

HOW TO HELP YOUR WASTEWATER OPERATOR

ABOUT YOUR SYSTEM

The septic tank on your property is actually owned, maintained, and repaired by the District. Property owners are, however, responsible for any plumbing infrastructure maintenance leading from the house or building to the connection of the tank. The District maintains equipment from the tank to the mainline.

HOW TO HELP

- Don't flush trash into your system, including coffee grounds, egg shells, kitchen fats, oils and greases, hand wipes, paper towels, rags, newspaper, sanitary napkins, condoms, diapers, cotton swabs, dental floss, cigarettes, or kitty litter.
- Keep septic tank and meter boxes clear to ensure access, including keeping vegetation pruned.
- Don't park vehicles over the tank or any other part of the system.
- Provide the District with codes or keys for gates for ease of access.
- Report any issues with your system by calling the number listed on the control box .
