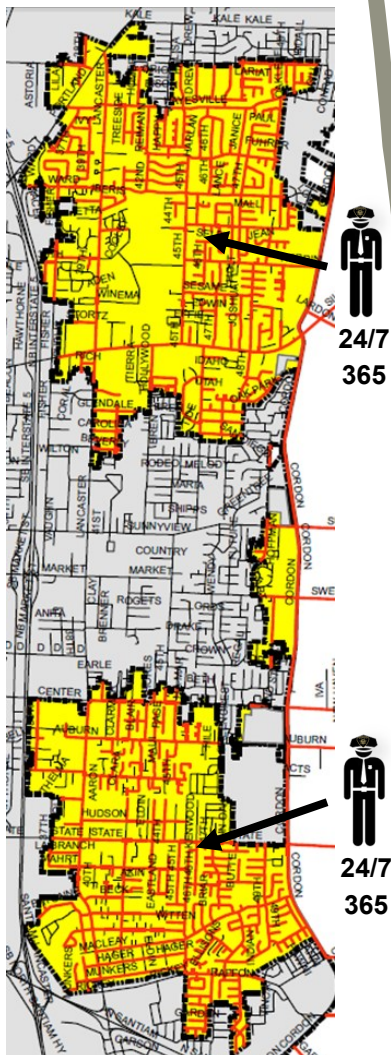
Hayesville and Four Corners Communities

Why Are 10 Deputies Needed?

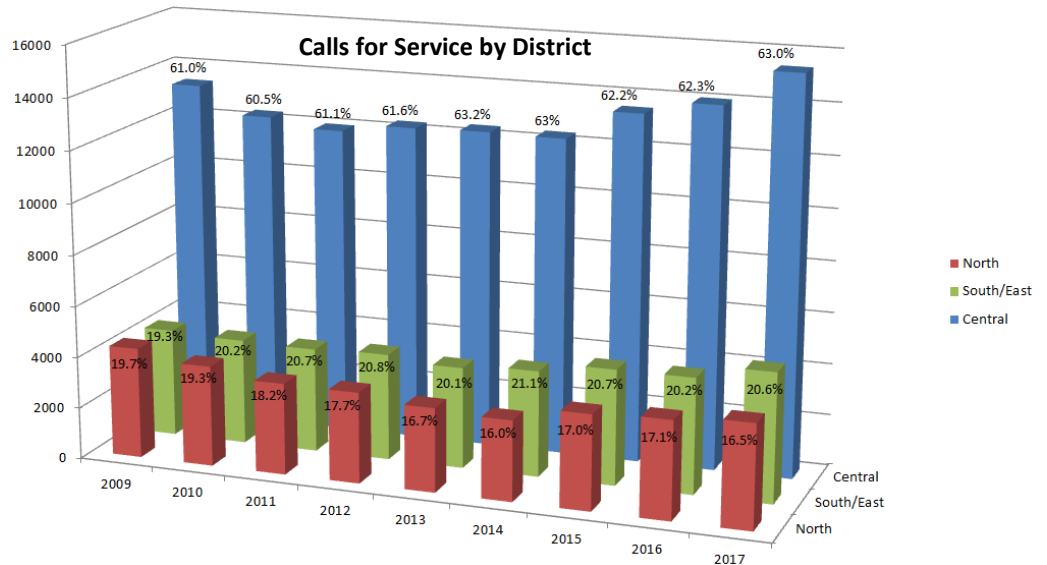


While not incorporated cities, the communities of Hayesville and Four Corners, have many of the characteristics and defined boundaries that make them similar to cities unto themselves. Combined, the two areas have a population nearly the size of Keizer and a higher population density than Keizer or Salem. It's time to consider dedicated public safety services for the communities of Hayesville and Four Corners. We've heard from community members —

overwhelmingly, the message is: *"we want to see you in our neighborhoods."* If approved, you'd still receive the benefit of the supporting services of our detectives, community resource unit, traffic team, and more. Your patrol deputies would enhance those services by focusing on your neighborhoods, hearing your concerns, participating in activities that are important to you and serving as a expert liaison for other services offered by Marion County.

What could this mean for my neighborhood?

- You'd have a deputy in your neighborhood 24 hours a day, seven days a week (see map at left). It takes five deputies to fully staff the shifts required for one 24/7 position.
- You'd get to know your deputies. We all benefit from familiarity between deputies and the residents they serve.
- We believe in being problem-solvers. With dedicated deputies, you'd have a chance to build relationships and work together to resolve community concerns.
