County appraisers visit properties throughout the year to determine value. Appraisers might visit your property to:

- Verify the terms and conditions of a recent sale
- Verify and/or update the property characteristics
- Appraise new construction
- Appraise remodels and additions
- Appraise property for removal of exemptions or adjudications from prior appeals
- Verify the use of the property complies with special assessment programs

This is not an all-inclusive list. Appraisers may visit the property for other reasons. Generally, appraisers will leave a business card on the front door. If you have received a business card, contact the appraiser directly at the number or email address listed on the card with questions regarding their visit.

You do NOT have to let an appraiser on your property. However, without a physical appraisal, we will use the best information available to us and the resulting RMV may not be a true reflection of your property.

To confirm an appraiser is with the county and should be on your property call our office 503-588-5144.

** When asked county employees should always provide county identification, typically will have county badge, county logo attire on or in a vehicle with county stickers on.
