Summary of presentation:

- IDDAC will be volunteers;
- Advisory capacity to Health Advisory Board, DD program and Health Department Administrator on matters related to Intellectual and Development Disabilities (IDD); and

<u>Tax Foreclosed Real Property – Tax Account #R68022</u> – Scott Norris, Caron Galvin-Price

Summary of presentation:

- House sits on lots R68022 and R68023. County acquired lot R68023 through foreclosure process;
- County placed encroachment easement on lot R68023; and
- If no bidders, county may sell lot to owners of R68022.

Board discussion:

- County required to hold auction to dispose of property;
- Auction set for October 2 in Senator Hearing Room;
- Encroachment easement protects county and owners of lot R68022;
- Possibility that owners of R68022 may not be high bidder;
- Bidders need to be made aware of encroachment easement on lot R68023;

- No advantage in delaying auction;
- Land sale process; and
- Property Specialist Caron Galvin-Price to discuss possible auction outcomes with Communications and Administrative Manager Jolene Kelley who has been in contact with owners of lot R68022.

Board direction:

Prior to auction, discuss encroachment easement issue with auctioneer Civil Deputy Brian Wallace.

Health Plan Renewal Plan Year - Justine Flora

Summary of presentation:

- Reviewed health plan renewal recommendations for 2015 (Attachment B);
 - o MODA:
 - PPOs no increase; and
 - Consumer Directed Health Plan renewal rate 0.3 percent decrease; however, deductible increased.
 - o Kaiser:
 - Difficult negotiations;
 - Initial renewal rate 16.2 percent increase;
 - Marion County Law Enforcement Association (MCLEA) Kaiser program renewed separately from MCLEA;
 - Health Insurance Study Committee (HISC) developed plans to reduce renewal rate; and
 - Final renewal rate 3.2 percent increase.
- Increase in Health Savings Arrangement (H.S.A.) employer contribution.

Board discussion:

- Monthly cap;
- County's cost will increase by \$2 million annually;
- Consequences of employees selecting MODA over Kaiser;
- HISC recommendations for Kaiser HMO;
- Increase under contract reopener;
- County not required to provide HMO option; and
- Incentivizing employees to choose MODA.
