Consider approval of Amendment #3 to the incoming funds Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) to add \$3,424,785.46 for a new contract total of \$10,495,955.46 of which an estimated \$8,468,242.71 is provided in federal funds and an estimated \$2,027,712.75 will be provided in county funds for the Hayesville Drive Bike and Pedestrian Improvement Project through August 24, 2026. –Ryan Crowther
