Shall the district impose \$0.68 per \$1,000 assessed value beginning 2024 for five years, for continued emergency service operation. This measure renews current local option taxes.

**Summary** 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

The Idanha-Detroit Rural Fire Protection District Board of Directors determined the need to request additional funding to provide fire and emergency medical service operations.

The Fire District Board desires to be good stewards of tax payer money while providing the best possible service for our communities. With existing revenues failing to fund adequate operations, the Board decided to ask the taxpayers to renew the five year local option levy in order to maintain the proper level of emergency response service.

The revenue from the passing of the operational levy will be used to maintain the current staffing of two (2), 40 hour a week medic / firefighters during the peak season May 15 - September 30. This would allow for the quick response of personnel to suppress fire, save lives and property.

The proposed rate of \$0.68 would generate approximately \$42,701.00 in 2024-2025, \$43,982.00 in 2025-2026, \$45,301.00 in 2026-2027, \$46,660.00 in 2027-2028 and \$48,059.00 in 2028-2029 for a total of \$226,703.00 over the five years.
