## **BUSINESS SERVICES**

Approve the following recommendations:

- Establish and adopt two classifications; Budget and Grants Manager, and Deputy District Attorney 4;

# Summary of presentation:

- The new Sheriff's Office central district office building and parole and probation building is being constructed on two parcels;
- To connect to the sewer system, the sewer connection crosses the property line;
- Because the properties are in Salem, Marion County has submitted applications with the city for building permits;
- The permitting process dealt with the sewer aspect;
- Because the sewer line crosses the property lines, the city required a Property Boundary Verification form;
- Doesn't change the property lines for all purposes; and
- The city has asked for the county to act on executing the Property Boundary Verification and file it with the Clerk's Office.

#### Board discussion:

- Update on the new building:
  - o The wood framing is complete on the new building;
  - o The interior metal stud framing is wrapping up;
  - o The mechanical, electrical, and plumbing are well underway;
  - o The roof is being installed right now;
  - o Everything seems to be on track;
  - o Exterior weather seal is being installed;
  - o Progressing very well; and
  - o No issues with the project.

#### **FINANCE**

A. Public hearing to consider adopting the second supplemental budget for fiscal year 2017-18. – Jeff White, Debbie Gregg

# Summary of presentation:

- A public notice was published in the Statesman Journal last Thursday;
- Supplemental budget request has been available for review not only on the county website, but also in the Board of Commissioners Office;
- The supplemental request was reviewed in detail during the February 5<sup>th</sup> Management Update Meeting;
- 16 funds have been modified in total;
- Six funds have increased;
- Several funds were modified due to collective bargaining negotiations with not only Marion County Law Enforcement Association (MCLEA), but also the Federation of Oregon Parole and Probation Officers (FOPPO):
  - o Affected the General Fund for \$557,000;
  - o Inmate Welfare Fund for \$9,000;
  - o The Sheriff's Grant Fund for \$8,000;
  - o Traffic Safety Team Fund for \$30,000;
  - o Community Corrections Fund for \$156,000; and
  - Most of the costs were covered by offsetting reductions in either contingency or materials and services.
- The Capital Improvement Project Fund had an increase for \$185,000 due to increases in the public safety building furnishings;
- Facility Renovation Fund had an increase for the HVAC transition center project of \$233,000, but it is being covered by contingency;
- The Health Find increased by \$705,000 due to intergovernmental state agreements:
  - o Covers various public health grants;
  - o HIV outreach; and
  - o Rental Assistance Programs.
- The Non-Departmental Grants Fund increased by \$163,000 due to the new Marion County Veterans Services Program that is being funded through the Oregon Department of Veterans Affairs; and
- Public Works Fund increased by \$131,000 for various ongoing capital projects.

#### Board discussion:

- Went through the supplemental budget in detail at Management Update;
- The detailed sheet is available online; and
- Ms. Gregg is doing a great job and her hard work is greatly appreciated.

**MOTION:** Commissioner Brentano moved to close the public hearing and adopt the second supplemental budget for fiscal year 2017-18. Seconded by Commissioner Carlson; motion carried. A voice vote was unanimous.

Commissioner Carlson read the calendar.
