Idanha-Detroit Ambulance Service Area - Rod Calkins

Summary of presentation:

- Idanha-Detroit Rural Fire Protection District (RFPD) is requesting extension of due date for application to renew franchise for ambulance service area (ASA);
- Idanha-Detroit RFPD on one-year contract due to difficulties of running ambulance in small population/tax base;
- Other ASA franchises on five-year contracts;
- Application for renewal was due by September 2, 2014. County received application to renew on September 5, 2014;
- No other applications received;
- Marion County Code allows board to change renewal period by order;
- If application accepted, administrator would perform contract extension review and report to board in November with recommendation on whether or not to extend contract.
