Board Committee Appointment – Public Safety Coordinating Council

Approve orders appointing the City of Keizer Police Chief, Andrew Copeland and reappointing City of Salem Police Chief, Trevor Womack, and Oregon State Police Lieutenant, Chris Zohner, to the Marion County Public Safety Coordinating Council with term dates beginning March 14, 2024, and ending March 14, 2027.
- 2. Approve Amendment #1 to the Subrecipient Agreement with the City of Aurora to revise Exhibit A.1 of the application for the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Downtown Core Water Transmission Line Improvements to update project dates, adjust the budget, and update the project team, with no additional funding required, through March 31, 2026.
