There were 10,711 confirmed cases of child abuse and neglect in Oregon in 2022 and 1,098 of these were victims in Marion County.
	As in previous years, there will be a Blue Ribbon Tree serving as a symbol to the campaign's prevention efforts. This tree serves as a sobering reminder to our community why we must stay focused on preventing child abuse and neglect before it starts.




