TITLE: Board Resolution for Distribution of HB 5006 Funds

Issue, Description & Background: The State of Oregon is providing funding through HB 5006 for revenue losses to taxing districts due to the 2020 wildfires. The State of Oregon Department of Revenue requires a board resolution and application due December 1, 2021 to obtain the funding.

Financial Impacts: Funding received from the state will be used to provide revenues to taxing districts that lost revenue due to the 2020 wildfires.

Impacts to Department & External Agencies: Marion County Finance and the BOC will spend time calculating, submitting, receiving and disbursing the funds. Marion County, as one of the taxing districts that lost property tax revenue due to the wildfires, will be a recipient of a share of the distribution.

Options for Consideration: 1) Adopt the resolution and submit the application to receive the 1st distribution of HB 5006 funding 2) Not submit the application, not adopt the resolution and not submit the application resulting in no funding from the state.

Recommendation: 1) Adopt the resolution and submit the required application

This matter came before the Marion County Board of Commissioners at its regularly scheduled public meeting on Wednesday, December 1, 2021.

WHEREAS, HB 5006 (2021) appropriated \$23,200,000 to the Department of Revenue "for grants to counties for the reimbursement of lost tax revenue related to the 2020 wildfires;" and

WHEREAS, the Department of Revenue requires a resolution authorizing a grant request from eligible counties; and

WHEREAS, the Marion County Board of Commissioners desires to authorize a grant request pursuant to HB 5006 (2021); now, therefore,

1. IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Marion County Board of Commissioners authorizes a grant request to the Department of Revenue pursuant to HB 5006 (2021) in the amount of \$715,634 for the 2020-21 tax year.
2. IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that Marion County will estimate the amount of lost property tax revenue for each taxing district in the county and allocate a prorated share of the HB 5006 grant to each district.
3. IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that Marion County will provide a report to the Department of Revenue, upon completion of the distribution of the funds, of the amounts distributed to each taxing district.
4. IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that a sworn statement is attached to this resolution as Exhibit A declaring that the request amount represents estimated revenue

lost in property tax years 2020-21 and 2021-22 due to the September 2020 wildfires.
