TITLE: Appointments to the Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Advisory Committee (IDDAC)

Issue, Description & Background: The Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Advisory Committee (IDDAC) is established in accordance with OAR 411-320-0030 (11) for oversight of the Marion County Community Developmental Disabilities Programs, and ORS 430.631 as the disability issues advisory committee. The IDDAC participates with the Marion County Health Department in planning local programs, and oversight of local resources and services that address the needs of IDD individuals. Four qualified applicants are recommended for appointment to the IDDAC for four-year terms ending June 30, 2027. Michelle Silbernagel and Richard Falardeau currently serve on the IDDAC, and have expressed their interest in serving an additional term; applicants Deborah Stoyer and Ross Ryan are able and willing to serve, and have been recommended by the IDDAC.
