#### SIXTH AMENDMENT TO OREGON HEALTH AUTHORITY 2019-2021 INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE FINANCING OF PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES

This Sixth Amendment to Oregon Health Authority 2019-2021 Intergovernmental Agreement for the Financing of Public Health Services, effective July 1, 2019, (as amended the "Agreement"), is between the State of Oregon acting by and through its Oregon Health Authority ("OHA") and Marion County, ("LPHA"), the entity designated, pursuant to ORS 431.003, as the Local Public Health Authority for Marion County.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, covenants and agreements contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows
